

## VOTER INFORMATION

### Who can vote?

In order to vote, you must be at least 18 years old, a U.S. citizen, registered to vote and a resident of the Broadalbin-Perth Central School District for at least 30 days prior to the May 18 vote.

### How do I register to vote?

Residents who have registered to vote in general elections are automatically registered to vote on the Broadalbin-Perth school budget. District residents who have not registered to vote in general elections may register to vote on the school budget between 6 and 8 p.m., Wednesday, May 12, at either the middle school gymnasium or the high school auditorium lobby.

### Can I vote by absentee ballot?

To vote by absentee ballot, you must fill out an application. Contact the district office at 954-2500 to obtain an application.

If you want your ballot mailed to you, your application must be received by May 11. If you plan to pick up your ballot, your application must be received by May 17. Absentee ballots must be returned to the district office by 5 p.m. on May 18.

### When and where is the vote?

The school budget vote will take place from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m., on Tuesday, May 18. Residents of Amsterdam, Fort Johnson, Gloversville, Hagaman and Johnstown vote in the middle school gymnasium; residents of Galway, Mayfield, Northville, Edinburg and Broadalbin vote in the lobby of the high school auditorium.
